## COURSE OBJECTIVE

This conversational isiXhosa course is an introduction to Xhosa speaking and assumes that the learner has no prior knowledge of the language. The course will focus on developing basic conversation skills and the facilitator will use examples from everyday situations to engage the delegates to practise their skills using dialogues and role-plays. In the process of building their vocabulary, delegates will also learn about isiXhosa customs and traditions.

- ask for help in various situations
- know numbers, days, months and seasons
- use question words to ask for quantities, weather situations and time
